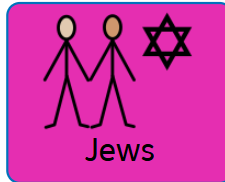


Key Vocabulary	
Baptism	A Christian welcoming ceremony where Holy water is sprinkled over the head.
Brit Bat	A Jewish ceremony to welcome and name baby girls.
Faith Community	A group of people who share the same religious beliefs.
Shabbat	The Jewish Day of Rest.
Challah bread	Jewish braided bread as a sign of being together.
Ceremony	an event to celebrate a special occasion.
