Christians believe in one God but they believe he exists in three parts or 'persons' (trinity). These are the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In Islam, Allah is believed to have 99 names in the Qur'an.	There are different denominations in Christianity.	The Christian Old Testament is also Jewish scripture.	Some people believe it is a way to communicate to God.

<p><b>Trinity</b> - Three persons in one God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.</p> <p><b>Tawhid</b> – the oneness of God.</p> <p><b>Shahadah</b>- first of the five pillars of Islam. The Muslim statement of faith in one God.</p> <p><b>Subha beads</b> – Islamic prayer beads.</p> <p><b>Five Pillars</b> - fundamental practices in Islam, considered to be obligatory acts of worship for all Muslims.</p>	<p><b>Hymns</b> - a religious song or poem of praise to God or a god.</p> <p><b>Communion</b> - the service of Christian worship.</p> <p><b>Eucharist</b> - A service celebrating the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ involving the sharing of the bread and wine.</p> <p><b>Denomination</b> – a group within a religion.</p>	<p><b>Testament</b> – a statement of belief.</p> <p><b>Verses</b> - These divisions are all there to help people find a sentence in the Bible quite easily.</p> <p><b>Genesis 1</b> – the beginning, the creation story.</p> <p><b>Scripture</b> - the sacred writings of a religion.</p> <p><b>Bible</b> – The Christian Holy book containing a collection of religious texts, writings, or scriptures.</p>	<p><b>Salat</b> – Muslim Daily prayers.</p> <p><b>Five Pillars</b> - fundamental practices in Islam, considered to be obligatory acts of worship for all Muslims.</p> <p><b>Subha beads</b> – Islamic prayer beads.</p> <p><b>Wudu</b> - washing to be performed to prepare for prayer and worship.</p> <p><b>The Lord's Prayer</b> – Christian prayer.</p> <p><b>Worship</b> - an act of religious devotion usually directed towards god/s.</p>
