#### **Statutory Assessment Results**

As you will know throughout the pupil's time in school they undertake a number of formal assessments that are set by the government. These assessments are used to assess whether children are ready for the next stage in their schooling and to judge school performance. I am delighted to inform you that your children have continued to achieve extremely well at Harcourt. Particular highlights include 82% of pupils passing the Phonics Screening Check in Year 1 and our Year 6 pupils outperforming the national average in Reading, Writing and Maths and Combined in KS2 SATS. This is an incredible achievement especially after the challenges the children faced during the COVID pandemic.
