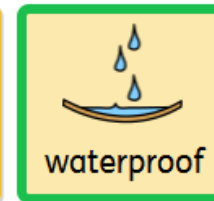
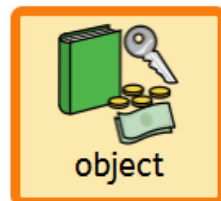
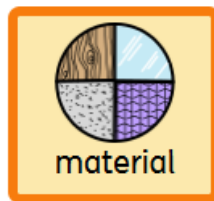

fragile	easily broken and delicate
fair test	a test where you control everything but one thing changes to answer a question.
waterproof	something that keeps water out, water cannot pass through.
