Key Vocabulary	Definition
Chronological order	Arranged in order as they occur, e.g. from when you wake up to when you go to bed.
Crime	Breaking the law, e.g. robbery.
Punishment	Something unpleasant which is done to somebody because of a crime being committed, e.g. prison.
Citizen	Someone who lives in a country or city, e.g. We are citizens of Great Britain.
Noble	Someone with a high social rank in society, e.g. Duke of Cambridge.
Slave	Someone who is owned by someone else, e.g. The genie is owned by the lamp in Aladdin.
Source	A person or book that provides information for research, e.g. a witness to an event.
