WELCOME BACK

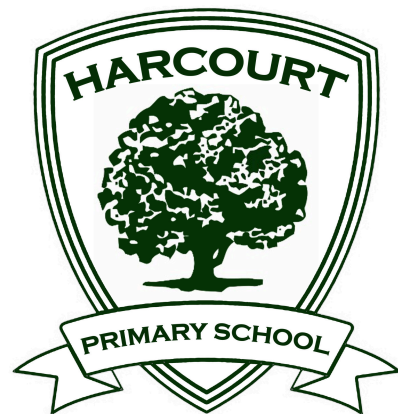
